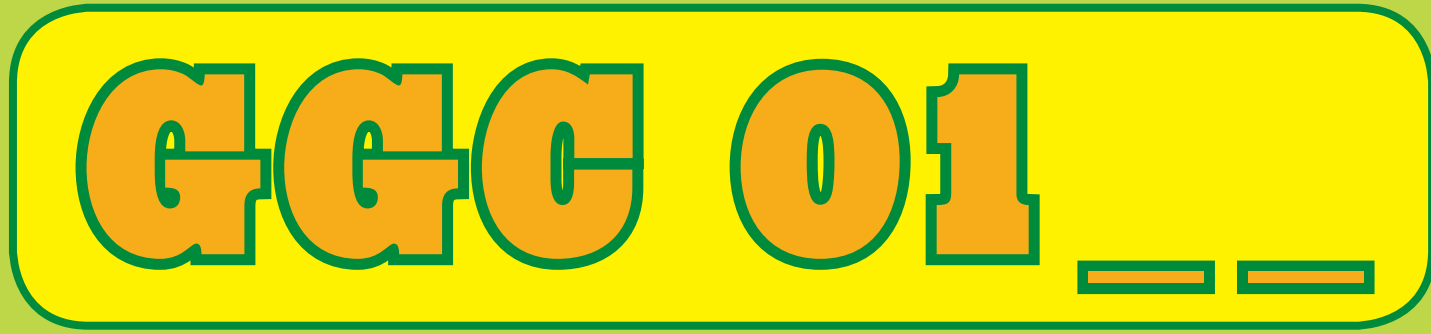


Instructions: Glue your bicycle number plate onto some card, then ask an adult to help you cut it out. Glue together the two sides of your number plate and use a hole punch to make the two holes. Tie a string through each hole of the number plate and then tie it to the handlebar of your bike. Finally, write your initials on the number plate using a permanent marker (for example PF stands for Professor Foodsmart).



Remember, when riding a bicycle, always wear a helmet!
